REQUIREMENTS:

- Essay is to be two pages, doubled spaced, with 1 inch margins discussing why you want to participate in this internship program.
- Academic transcript from your current school.
- One letters of reference from non-family members. It can be from employers, professors, clergymen, etc.
- Application with all requirements must be postmarked by May 13, 2018. An incomplete package will be deemed null and void.
- Application must be legible.
